Don is a woodworking artist and had a wealth of information to share on his specialty, natural edge furniture. The feedback from members is that this was a very fun and informative meeting.

#### **Presentation:**



We had a presentation by Mr. Don Juvet of Juvet Artistic Woodwork with a studio in Cameron Park. He specializes in the design and fabrication of natural edge furniture and showed us a number of examples of his work. He brought in one article, a very tall maple chair.

Don is a great speaker and gave a very good presentation. He answered numerous questions from our members covering everything from material handling, fabrication techniques and finishing. Don uses a large CNC machine in fabricating significant portions of his projects. Pictures of some of his work are included below. There is no doubt don is an exceptional artist. As you may note, a lot of Don's work tends toward the larger side.

Don uses free form design drawings in designing his projects. He has created woodcrafted items for businesses including wineries and notable individuals. One individual was Mr. James Rollins a New York Times bestselling author. It was a large natural edge

table of claro-walnut.
